Mission Statement

The Pink Ribbon Advocacy provides financial assistance to Barron County residents to help cover uninsured expenses associated with receiving breast cancer diagnosis and treatment.

Services Provided

Let's face it, even if you have the best of insurance, being a breast cancer patient involves out-of-pocket expenses. We don't want these expenses to stop you from getting the treatment you need. Some of the products and services we will help pay for include:

- Mammograms
- Gas to get to treatment
- Daycare for your children while you're at treatment
- Insurance co-pays
- Prescription co-pays
- Wigs
- Prosthetics
- Other needs will be considered

Guidelines

Each individual breast cancer patient can apply for up to \$250 per application, and can apply up to 3 times per calendar year (unless there are extenuating circumstances which require a decision by the board). Payment will be made to the service provider; gasoline will be paid for in the form of vouchers from participating gas stations.

How to Apply

Print an **Application Form**, complete it and mail it to us. (Once we become more web-savy, you'll be able to submit your application online. Until then, use the US Postal Service!) Applications will be reviewed by the Services Coordinator, and if approved, payment will be sent. You will be contacted if we have any questions regarding your application.

The Pink Ribbon Advocacy is a group of friends from the [Rice Lake Curling Club](#) with a common mission to "do what they could" to help eradicate breast cancer. With the help of the curling club, they started an event--Curl for a Cure--to raise funds and breast cancer awareness. Committee members wanted to use the funds to help local breast cancer patients, but no outlet existed. After 2 successful fund raisers, a subgroup of the Curl for a Cure committee set out to create a foundation to fulfill their original dream: to help local breast cancer patients in their fight against breast cancer.
